BUDGET – Assessor’s Salary and Expense Fund
For the year ending December 31, 2017

Our sources of revenue and estimated amounts to be received from each source are listed in our budget. Our expenditures are shown by Major Functions (Personnel Services, Operating Services, Materials and Supplies, Travel and Other Charges, and Capital Outlay) and then detailed under the Major Functions. We plan to use the available resources of this office to provide the most efficient Assessor’s office possible to the people of this parish.

- 1 – To list and place a value on all property that is subject to ad-valorem taxes.
- 2 – To compile a tax roll of all taxable property and file with the Louisiana Tax Commission.
- 3 - To maintain the best records possible.

Our objectives are to use the resources available to this office to the best possible advantage. We will work diligently to have the best personnel and equipment available.

This Budget was prepared on the modified accrual basis of accounting (GAAP BASIS).
